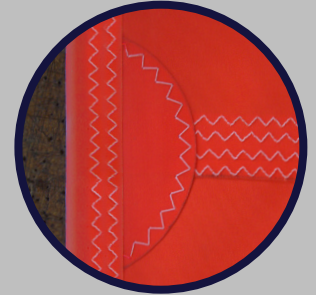

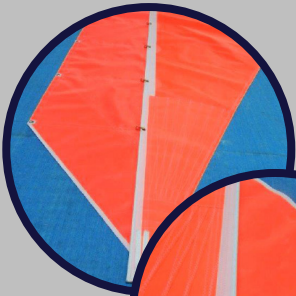
## Storm Jib



Hanks for easy attachment



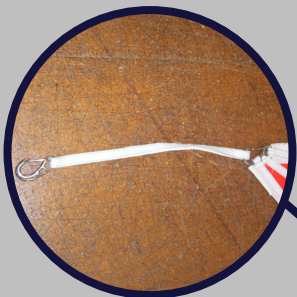
Leech reinforcement



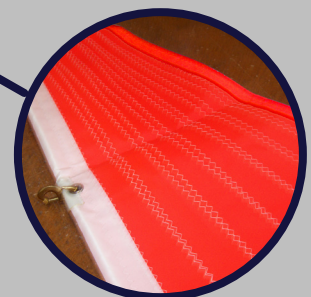
Option of sleeve on luff to wrap around roller headsail



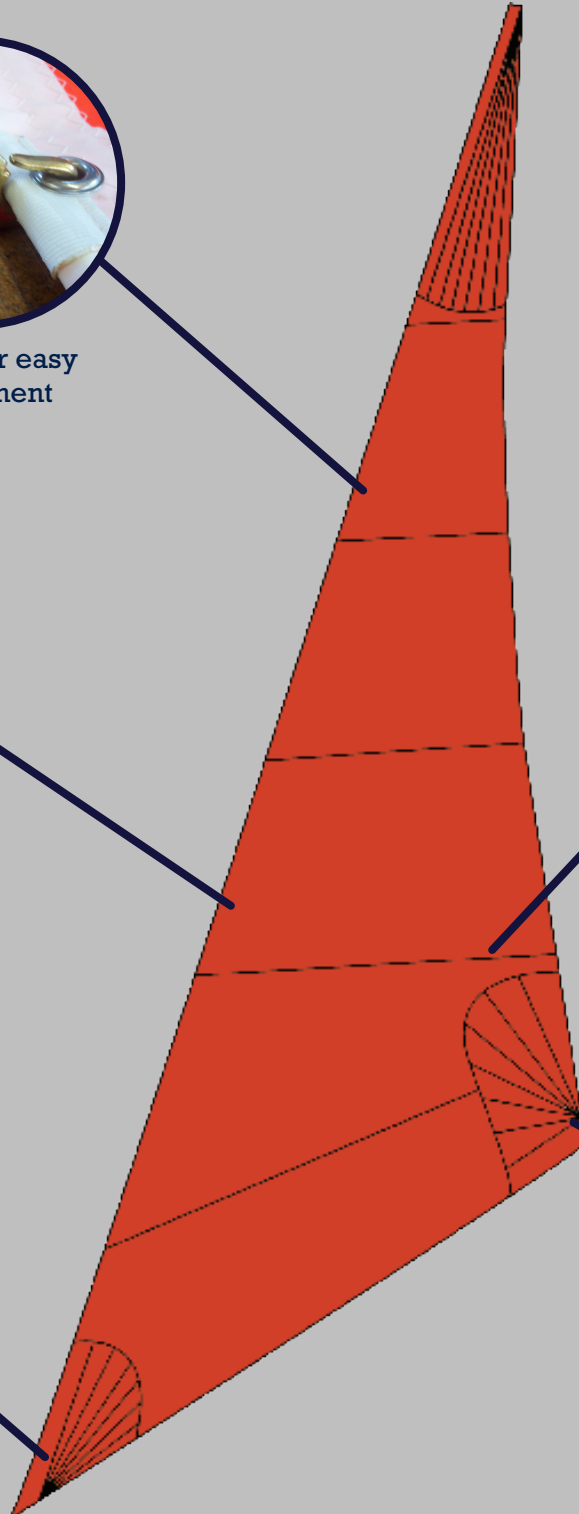
Multiple rows of stitching on seams

Dart Sails Storm sails are not off the shelf, they are custom designed and cut individually to suit the deck and spars. Badly setting Storm Sails are a liability not what you need when your life or your children's life depends on sailing away from a lee shore in a Gale! We take comprehensive measurements and computer design our Storm Sails just like all other sails and they are built here at our loft. The seams have at least 3 rows of 3-step anti snag stitching for ultimate reliability. Available in High Visibility orange or top quality premium white rip stop

fabric with a large contrasting stripe across the sail. Our Storm sails conform to ISAF, ORC and Charter Coding safety regulations. It is highly recommended that the sail is hanked onto the forestay or a separate dedicated Inner-forestay (usually removable). Sleeves to wrap around a rolled up Genoa are not ideal as they are not easy to fit on a bouncing foredeck in Storm conditions however we do offer a wrap-around sleeve as an 'Emergency Just in Case' scenario for boats where an independent stay is impractical.
